Regular Meeting of April 1, 2019

The Princeton Community Development Corporation met in a regular session in the City Council Chamber at City Hall, located at 123 West Princeton Drive, Princeton, Texas on Monday, April 1, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. The following CDC Board of Directors were present: President Steve Deffibaugh, Vice-President David Kleiber, Directors Damon Williams, Mary Hodges, and David Bishop. The following Staff Members were present: City Manager, Derek Borg, and CDC/EDC Coordinator Nakia Patton.

President Steve Deffibaugh presided and called the CDC Meeting to order at 3:02 PM.

President Deffibaugh called roll, present were Vice-President David Kleiber, Directors Williams, Hodges, and Bishop. Not present was Director Rubio. Place 4 is Vacant.

President Deffibaugh led the Directors and audience in the invocation.

Director Hodges led the Directors and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Director Williams led the Directors and audience in the Texas Pledge.

President Deffibaugh then announced Citizen Appearance. No one spoke.

President Deffibaugh then announced the Consent Agenda: All consent agenda items listed are considered to be routine by the Community Development Corp. and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Director so request, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda.

Director Bishop made a motion to approve RESOLUTION NO. CD 2019-03-04-R and the minutes from the Regular Community Development Corporation meeting of February 4, 2019. Director Williams seconded the motion. The motion carried.

President Deffibaugh then announced the first item under the Regular Agenda: **(Item 1)** “Presentation and discussion regarding the development of City maps from Joni Margotta, Business Development Leader at Stantec Consultants.” **President Deffibaugh made a motion to approve the development of City maps from Stantec Consultants. Director Hodges seconded the motion. Motion carries.**

President Deffibaugh then announced the second item under the Regular Agenda **(Item 2)** “Discussion and possible action regarding a partnership with the City of Princeton on the issuance of a tax note for construction and renovation of the Community Center.” **Director Bishop made a motion to approve the issuance of a tax note for construction and renovation of the Community Center. Director Kleiber seconded the motion. Motion carries.**

President Deffibaugh then announced the third item under the Regular Agenda **(Item 3)** “Discussion and possible action regarding the Parkview Heights Park commemoration event for May 4, 2019.” **Director Hodges made a motion to schedule the Parkview Heights commemoration event for May 4, 2019 from 11a.m. to 1 p.m. Director Bishop seconded the motion. Motion carries.**

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the fourth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 4**) "Discussion and possible action regarding CEIS electronic message boards." No action taken.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the fifth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 5**) "Presentation and discussion regarding future commercial development in Princeton and electronic message signage from Praveen Daida, Princeton Pharmacy." No action taken.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the sixth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 6**) "Discussion and possible action regarding automatic electronic defibrillator devices presentation by Dustin Lankford from the Princeton Fire Department." Item tabled.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the seventh item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 7**) "Presentation and discussion regarding storm sirens at City parks from Chase Bryant, Parks & Recreation Director and Perry Weather. Director **Hodges** made a motion to approve the purchase of the Perry Weather system. Director **Williams** seconded the motion. Motion carries.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the eighth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 8**) "Update regarding the construction of the J.M. Caldwell Sr. Community Park Dog Park presented by Kimley-Horn and Chase Bryant." No action taken.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the ninth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 9**) "Discussion and possible action regarding the current CDC Budget, Debt information, and Financial Balance Statement." No action taken.

President **Deffibaugh** then announced the tenth item under the Regular Agenda (**Item 10**) "Consider a request for items to be placed on future agenda and NOT for discussion.



**A RESOLUTION OF THE 4B COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION
ESTABLISHING THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR A SPECIFIC PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Princeton 4B Corporation is authorized to undertake this "Project" under Subchapter D. *Authorized Projects*, Section 505.152. "*Projects related to Recreational or Community Facilities*", of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the 4B Corporation receives sales tax revenues for park improvements from certain developments within the City; and

WHEREAS, the 4B has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Princeton to commit funding from sales tax revenues for the purchase of a Weather Warning System at the JM Caldwell Community Park; and

WHEREAS, the staff solicited the estimates for the Perry Weather System product and cost was approved by the Corporation at the April 1st meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Community Development Corporation has determined the amount of **\$15,619** be allocated from the 4B Corporations sales tax revenue and the appropriate Budget adjustments are made for the above mentioned project; and

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRINCETON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION,
THAT THE FUNDS ARE HEARBY COMMITTED FOR THE ABOVE MENTIONED PROJECT.**


