

Lois Nelson Public Library Code of Conduct

1. All persons using the library facility or services must act in a manner that does not interfere with the rights of others in their use and enjoyment of library services, or the library staff's ability to provide services.
2. Ensure children under the age of 13 have responsible adult supervision at all times.
3. Remember to be mindful of all personal items, as the library staff does not accept for loss or damage of personal items. Remain alert to your surroundings.
4. When using a cellphone, be respectful of other library patrons and keep the volume and duration of any call to a minimum.
5. When listening to music or other electronic devices, be respectful of other library patrons and keep the volume at a level only you can hear.
6. Only service animals are allowed in the library.
7. Park your bicycle in the bicycle rack at the front of the building.
8. Keep walkways clear and leave furniture where it is placed.
9. Treat library materials, equipment and facilities with care.
10. Refrain from inappropriate dress in this public forum.
11. Inappropriate, discriminatory, and vulgar speech is not allowed.
12. Consumption of drugs, alcohol, and use of tobacco products (including e-cigarettes and vapes) are prohibited.

Those violating rules will be asked to stop aforementioned actions. If the behavior continues, they will be asked to leave the library for the day. Additional offenses may result in the individual being barred from the Library.
