Applicant Requirements:

- Class C Texas Driver’s License, plus proof and maintenance of auto insurance.
- Must speak and have a thorough comprehension of the English language
- Good moral character - Integrity, Respect, Dependability, Strong Work Ethic, Unselfishness
- Must complete an application and turn it into Princeton City Hall with notarization.
- Must attend meetings and training regularly
- Additional department requirements apply once accepted as a member – Call for details
- Background investigation required

Certification Requirements:

- TCFP Structure FF Certified, or SFFMA Certified.
- EMT-Basic or higher certification
- Additional certification requirements after hire

Our department is a combination department consisting of full-time, part-time, and volunteer firefighters. These dedicated men and women are committed to helping the community, with a focus on quality service to the citizens of Princeton. We provide both fire and emergency medical services 24 hours a day 365 days a year. Our department is staffed by approximately 40 personnel responding to approximately 2,600 calls annually. We employ a first responder Advanced Life Support capable system and support American Medical Response’s (AMR) ALS Ambulance housed at our fire station.
