Special Emergency Council Meeting of April 2, 2020

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Texas, met in Special Emergency Session via teleconference on April 2, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

The following Councilmembers were present: Councilmember David Kleiber, Councilmember Mike Robertson, Councilmember Nikki Krum, Councilmember Richard Sheehan and Mayor Pro-Tempore Steve Deffibaugh. Mayor John – Mark Caldwell was present. The following Staff Members were present: City Manager Derek Borg, City Secretary Tabatha Monk, Assistant City Manager Lesia Gronemeier, Director of Development Services Shawn Fort, Director of Finance Carron Prigmore, Police Chief Mark Moyle, Fire Chief Tom Harvey, Director of Public Works Tommy Mapp and Director of Parks and Recreation Chase Bryant.

Mayor Caldwell called the City Council Meeting to order at 9:02 PM.

Mayor Caldwell called roll, present were Councilmembers **David Kleiber, Mike Robertson, Nikki Krum, Richard Sheehan and Steve Deffibaugh.**

Mayor Pro-Tempore **Deffibaugh**, led the invocation.


Mayor **Caldwell** then announced the first item under the Special Agenda:

(2020-034): "Consideration and action regarding the Third Revised Mayoral Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency (COVID-19), updating the City's disaster response measures and local emergency restrictions on gatherings, non-essential travel, and business activities." Mayor Pro-Tempore Deffibaugh made a motion to approve the 4th Revised Mayoral Declaration of Local State of Disaster due to Public Health Emergency (COVID-19). Councilmember Robertson seconded the motion to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Caldwell then announced the second item under the Special Agenda:
(2020-035): "Consideration and action regarding renewing or extending by ordinance the Mayor's most recent proclamation of COVID-19 disaster." Mayor Pro-Tempore Deffibaugh made a motion to approve Ordinance 2020-04-02, with the change of City of Princeton to Item 6 on page 3 of 5. Councilmember Krum seconded the motion to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Caldwell called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mayor Pro Tempore Deffibaugh made a motion to adjourn. Councilmember Robertson seconded the motion to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 9:35 a.m.


